- Rules and Regs:** in following order:
1. Bidding / will be posted at the comp office
2. DHV-competition regulations
3. FAI Sporting Code
- Participants:** Number of participants is limited to a maximum of 70 pilots (50 German and max. 30 foreign pilots). Pilots have to be German League / Cadre 2011, regular German pilots, foreign pilots as well as other qualified pilots according to the DHV-competition regulations.
- Scoring:** Rebekka Speckenheuer
- Scoring-Software:** GPS Dump, FS Comp
- Competition Settings:** GAP 2008 with following settings: Use Arrival Position Points, Use Time Points, Use Leading Points
- Radio-Frequency:** 147,350 – 20 kHz – 5 Watt - dB – 300 m

- Liability:** Every participant takes part on his own risk. Claims against the organizer/host and its supporters due to simple negligence are excluded. (Acc. TO non liability statement)
- Prerequisites:** Valid pilot license/foreign pilot license, valid liability insurance, FAI license 2011 (at the day of enrollment). Airworthy glider with valid type test (airworthiness certificate) and single conformity inspection, tested helmet acc. EN 966. Signed liability- and participation declaration for DHV competitions. The documents will be checked at enrollment. The only means of documentation is a GPS with altitude recording.
- Pitch Control:** **Measurement of spoke setting (Class 1)**
1. There will be checks of the spoke setting. The opportunity of a voluntary spoke setting measurement will be available for pilots one day prior the first task. Checks during the competition will be performed at the official landing field but may be taken on launch in special situations.
 2. All measurements will be published with the pilots' name and glider particulars as well as the certified setting. Measurements will be made of sprog systems, but may also include other dimensional measurements.
 3. All gliders must have their sprogs set to the certified settings of a recognized testing body (DHV, HGMA or BHPA) or to a manufacturer's declared safe setting. Any glider with sprog settings which exceed either the certified settings by + or – 2 degrees or the manufacturer's declared safe settings by 0.5 degree will be reported to the Meet Director.
 4. A glider with a tail will have to have the certified tail dimensions and angle setting published. It is the responsibility of the pilot to supply these values to the meet director.
 5. Prototypes will be allowed in the competition as long as the pilot supplies a letter of approval from the manufacturer and documentation from the manufacturer that the glider has passed a pitch test. The settings of the pitch devices (sprogs, tail, etc.) must be provided and measurements will be taken according to these numbers. The tolerances specified in paragraph 3 will also apply to these measurements.
 6. Gliders will also be measured randomly during the competition. All subsequent measurements will be published. If a pilot is found to have flown with non-compliant settings when measured after a task, the Meet Director will be notified. The penalty for deliberate non-compliance will be 5% of the maximum available score for that task. In addition, the glider will be measured again the next day. If the sprogs are again found to be non-compliant, the pilot will not be allowed to fly the task (i.e. will receive no score).
 7. Measurements will be performed by leveling the glider in longitudinal and horizontal axes with full stock VG setting applied. Angle measurements of the individual sprogs with respect to the keel will be taken to be the sprog settings.

 2. The 130 € starting fee has to be transferred (has to be there till 02 May 2002). If the money is late there will be the original fee of 150.-€ due. (banking dat on the form)

There is the chance of a last minute entry if throe are less than 70 pilots enrolled but only at 150.-€ fee.

- GPS- Registration:** Tuesday, 10 May 2011 from 17:00 to 22:00 in the competition office, Please hand in all GPS units (including backups) as early as possible.-
- Starting Fee:** up to 02.05.11 – 130 €, from 03.05.11 on – 150 €.
- The registration is only granted after the receipt of the money.
In case of a pilot no show there will be no refund of the starting fee (except any case of medical indications with an official doctor´s statement.)
If the competition will not be performed due to weather problem there will be a 50% refund.
- Included in fee:** Transport of pilots and equipment to the launch site (material transport is on own risk). Charts with turning points and coordinates, pilots handy-sheet with all important telephone numbers, frequencies, scoring, pilots party, trophies and cups.
- Pick Up:** The pilots have to organize their pick up´s on their own!
- Reporting back:** every pilot has to report back immediately after landing via SMS and with a run report in the time span announced in the briefing, at the competition office. A pilot that did not report back will be searched for with all available means. The costs of the search will be asked from such a pilot.
- Execution:** Starting Sunday 08 May, 12:00, there will be more information on www.dhv.de about the competition.
- Prices:** Trophies, Cups, price money (according number of participants)
- Right for Changes:** The organizer/host reserve the right for changes of the bidding.
