- Participants:** Number of participants is limited to a maximum of 70 pilots (50 German and max. 30 foreign pilots). Pilots have to be German League / Cadre 2012, regular German pilots, foreign pilots as well as other qualified pilots according to the DHV-competition regulations.
- Scoring:** Rebekka Speckenheuer
- Scoring-Software:** GPS Dump, FS Comp
- Competition Settings:** GAP 2008 with following settings: Use Arrival Position Points, Use Time Points, Use Leading Points

Radio-Frequency: 147,350 – 25 kHz – 5 Watt – 3 dB

Liability: Every participant takes part on his own risk. Claims against the organizer/host and its supporters due to simple negligence are excluded. (Acc. TO non liability statement)

Prerequisites: Valid pilot license/foreign pilot license, valid liability insurance, FAI license 2012(at the day of enrollment). Airworthy glider with valid type test (airworthiness certificate) and single conformity inspection, tested helmet acc. EN 966. Signed liability- and participation declaration for DHV competitions. The documents will be checked at enrollment. The only means of documentation is a GPS with altitude recording. Gliders class 1 must be tested by a official testing institution. The sprog settings must be in writing. Manufacturer declarations of sprog settings are not accepted.

Pitch Control: Measurement of sprog setting (Class 1)

1. There will be checks of the sprog setting. The opportunity of a voluntary sprog setting measurement will be available for pilots one day prior the first task. Checks during the competition will be performed at the official landing site but also possible at the launch site if necessary. All measured values will be published, only voluntary measurements prior to the competition will be confidential.

2. The measurements will be performed as follows. The gliders will be leveled along the longitudinal and diagonal axis while the VG will be tightened to the maximum serial production value. Angle measurements of the individual stop settings in relation to the keel will be used as setting values. If the test institution specifies a different method for a glider, this method will be applied.

3. All gliders have to use stop setting values as certified by an FAI-accredited test institution. Gliders with sprog settings below the certified setting are not allowed to take off. All gliders that do not fulfill the above limits will be reported to the competition director.

4. If the setting measured after a task is below the certified setting, the pilot will be penalized according to the rules for cloud flying in FAI Sect. 7a. The glider has to be readjusted by the pilot and it is not allowed to take off until an official measurement confirms a correct setting.

5. Tolerances: Measurements are carried out using electronic level gages having a resolution of 0.1 degree or better. According to CIVL HG-SC 2012 the sum of all effects on accuracy can be on the order of 1 degree. Deviations within this tolerance will not be penalized and will not lead to prohibition from take off. The pilot will be informed about any deviation and has to confirm this with his signature.

2. The 130 € starting fee has to be transferred (has to be there till 05 May 2012). If the money is late, there will be the original fee of 150.-€ due. (banking dat on the form)

There is the chance of a last minute entry if there are less than 70 pilots enrolled but only at 150.-€ fee.

GPS- Registration: Tuesday, 15. May 2012 from 17:00 to 22:00 in the competition office, Please hand in all GPS units (including backups) as early as possible.-

Starting Fee: up to 05.05.12 – 130 €, from 06.05.12 on – 150 €.

The registration is only granted after the receipt of the money.
 In case of a pilot no show there will be no refund of the starting fee (except any case of medical indications with an official doctor's statement.)
 If the competition will not be performed due to weather problem there will be a 50% refund.

- Included in fee:** Transport of pilots and equipment to the launch site (material transport is on own risk). Charts with turning points and coordinates, pilots handy-sheet with all important telephone numbers, frequencies, scoring, pilots party, trophies and cups.
- Pick Up:** The pilots have to organize their pick up's on their own!
- Reporting back:** every pilot has to report back immediately after landing via SMS and with a run report in the time span announced in the briefing, at the competition office. A pilot that did not report back will be searched for with all available means. The costs of the search will be asked from such a pilot.
- Execution:** Starting Sunday 13 May, 12:00, there will be more information on www.dhv.de about the competition.
- Prices:** Trophies, Cups, prize money (according number of participants)
- Right for Changes:** The organizer/host reserve the right for changes of the bidding.
